## OPENER: SFGS

**Lead to the right, Circle up four**

and **break make your line**

Without a stop **slide thru**, and **dosado** ...

**...Eight chain five** across the ring you fly

\*The night before Christmas, it was forty below

**Swing** old Snoopy and **promen-o**

To find the red baron seriously they fought

With ice on his wings, Snoopy knew he was lost

## MIDDLE BREAK: SFGS

The baron made Snoopy fly to the right

And forced him to land behind enemy lines

## CLOSER: SFGS

Christmas Bells! Oh, those Christmas Bells!
