## **OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK**

Sides face, grand square

Left allemande, swing and promenade

## **FIGURE**

Heads lead to the right, veer to the left and ladies hinge Diamond circulate, flip the diamond, ladies trade Recycle 'cross and then, veer left once again Ferris wheel, you move around that ring, dixie grand You're wearing your spurs, you're wearing your spurs Left allemande, come back, swing that girl and promenade She said "You give me a thrill when I sit on your knee You're weaving your spurs too high"

## **TAG**

Bow to your partner, corners too Shake your spurs, that's it, you're through
