Opener/Break/Closer: (Circle Left)

Left Allemande then DoSaDo her
Left Allemande and now you weave that ring
Are you from Alabama, Tennessee, or Caroline?
Swing your girl and you Promenade the line,
Are you from Dixie, I said from Dixie?
'Cause I'm from Dixie, too.

Figure:
The Heads promenade and take them
Half way around Walk in and square thru three hands now
You Cloverleaf and then the sides square thru
Three hands around and do a DosaDo make a wave
And the Girls Trade swing thru and then
Swing the corner lady and Promenade again
You're from my homeland, my sunny homeland,
Tell me can it be?
