

## SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE

You'd better watch out, you'd better not cry, you'd better not pout, I'm telling you why Santa Claus is coming to town

He's making a list & checking it twice, going to find out who's naughty or nice Santa Claus is coming to town **CIRCLE TO THE LEFT** 

He sees you when your sleeping, he knows if you're awake

ALLEMANDE LEFT the Corner, PROMENADE for goodness sake

You'd better watch out, you'd better not cry, you'd better not pout, I'm telling you why Santa Claus is coming to town

**BREAK:-** (Deck The Halls) - Check Brian's vocal for choreo variations.

**CLOSER:-** (Jingle Bells) - Check Brian's vocal for choreo variations.

**FIGURES #1 & #3**:- (Let It Snow & Rudolph The Red Nosed Reindeer)

**HEAD** (SIDE) **COUPLES SQUARE THRU** four hands you go now

Make a **RIGHT HAND STAR BUT ONLY GO HALF WAY** AS A COUPLE, VEER TO THE LEFT, FERRIS WHEEL PASS THRU, STAR THRU, SQUARE THRU (3/4)

Three Quarter round the ring you go now **SWING THE CORNER** and **PROMENADE** her

- And since we have no place to go Let it snow, let it snow, let it snow
- Rudolph the red nosed reindeer You'll go down in history

## **MELODY SEQUENCE**

Santa Claus Is Coming To Town Let It Snow Frosty The Snowman Deck The Halls Rudolph The Red Nosed Reindeer Winter Wonderland Jingle Bells (slow tag ending)

## **FIGURES #2 & #4**:- (Frosty The Snowman & Winter Wonderland)

**HEAD** (SIDE) COUPLES FLUTTER WHEEL across the ring you go now **SQUARE THRU** count **THREE HANDS** and then **CLOVERLEAF** and now **SIDE TWO PASS THRU** MAKE A RIGHT HAND STAR take a FULL TURN

FOLLOW THE HEAD MAN, He'll LEAD OUT. CIRCLE TO THE LEFT **CORNER SWING** and **PROMENADE** 

- \*\* The children say he could laugh & play Just the same as you & me
- \*\* What a beautiful sight, we're happy tonight Dancing in a Winter Wonderland
