SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE

Allemande Left and Weave

Swing and Promenade

FIGURE:

Heads (sides) Square Thru, four hands and go now Make Right Hand Star
Heads Star Left one time inside and then
Same two go Right and Left Thru
Half Sashay and then you
Swing that corner lady and Promenade her
And who left the door
To Heaven open
