

Opening and Middle Break
 Circle Left
 Frosty the Snowman
 Was a jolly happy soul
 With a corncob pipe and a button nose
 And his eyes made out of coal
 Left Allemande your corner
 Turn your partner by the right
 Left allemande your corner and weave around that ring
 You wind and weave around that ring you're going to roam
 You swing your partner there and promenade back home
 Frosty the Snowman
 Was alive as he could be
 And the children say
 He could laugh and play
 Just the same as you and me

Figure (Twice for Heads, twice for sides)
 Heads (sides) square through it 4 hands round you go
 Make a right-hand star and turn it once you know
 Heads (sides) star by the left one time around
 back to the corner now and do a right and left through
 Swing through, Swing through again
 Boys run and promenade back home
 *Frosty the Snowman
 Was alive as he could be
 And the children say
 He could laugh and play
 Just the same as you and me (Figure 1)

* Frosty the Snowman
 Had to hurry on his way
 But he waved goodbye
 Saying don't you cry
 I'll be back again someday (figure 3)

* For figure 2 and 4 no words, just 16 beats with the bells

Closer:
 Frosty the Snowman
 Knew the sun was hot that day
 So he said let's run
 And we'll have fun
 Now before I melt away
 Left Allemande your corner
 Turn your partner by the right
 Left allemande your corner and weave around that ring
 You wind and weave around that ring you're going to roam
 You swing your partner there and promenade back home
 Frosty the Snowman
 Had to hurry on his way
 But he waved goodbye
 Saying don't you cry
 I'll be back again some day

 Circle left (16 beats)
 Thumpety thump thump
 Thumpety thump thump
 Look at Frosty go
 Thumpety thump thump
 Thumpety thump thump
 Over the hills of snow
