OPENER & CLOSER: SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE

Mele Kalikimaka is the thing to say on a bright Hawaiian Christmas day

That's the island greeting that we send to you

From the land where palm trees sway ALLEMANDE & WEAVE

Here we know that Christmas will be green and bright

The sun will shine by day and all the stars at night

Mele Kalikimaka is the Hawaiian way to say Merry Christmas to you

FIGURE: (TWICE FOR THE HEADS, TWICE FOR THE SIDES)

SQUARE THRU 4, THEN YOU MAKE A RIGHT HAND STAR, THEN STAR BY THE LEFT IN THE MIDDLE & TURN IT ONE TIME, BACK TO THE SAME TWO AND DO THE RIGHT AND LEFT THRU (MAKE YOUR WAVES) SWING THRU AND THEN, COME ON AND DO THAT AGAIN, SWING YOUR CORNER AND PROMENADE

MIDDLE BREAK: 4 LADIES CHAIN, CHAIN THEM BACK, JOIN HANDS CIRCLE LEFT, DO AN ALLEMANDE LEFT YOUR CORNER, NOW WEAVE THE RING
