OPENER

Sides face, grand square

FIGURE

Head (side) two couples promenade it's 1/2 way Round there with your maid
Down the middle with a right & left thru
Turn a little girl, square thru and go
All the way to the outside two
Swing thru, it's two by two, boys run to the right
And then ferris wheel to the middle and go
Center two pass on thru
Touch 1/4, scoot back go
Swing the corner, promenade home

MIDDLE BREAK - CLOSER

Walk around the left hand lady
Come on home a dopaso, partner left
Corner by the right, back to partner
Hang on tight, boys swing into the middle and star
Back right up in an allemande thar, slip the clutch
Left allemande, weave around the ring, my friend
*You can't go home if you're goin' by the mill

Take her by the hand and you promenade
