OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK - CLOSER

Circle left

\*Lord a-mercy, land a-goshen

Shades of gray out on the ocean

Don't you dare take that boat out to sea

Left allemande your corner, come back and dosado

Left allemande, weave the ring

\*\*Cause out there in the gulf the wind is blowing like a bandit

Swing your lady round and promenade around that ring

There's an ill wind blowin', you better get back to your mooring

Don't you dare take that boat out to sea

ALTERNATE LYRICS

(middle break)

\*You better give up on your shrimpin',

or you might come home a-limpin'

If you dare take that boat out to sea

\*\*I'm talkin' 'bout a hurricane, your rigging will not stand it

(closer)

\*You better take a weather warning

or you'll be shark bait in the morning

If you dare take that boat out to sea

FIGURE Plus, corner progression

Heads square thru in the middle and get four hands you go

Dosado that outside two

Swing thru and then girls fold and peel the top

Boys move up and do the right & left thru

Square thru 3 hands around, corner lady swing

Swing on the corner lady, promenade around that ring

There's an ill wind blowin', you better get back to your mooring
