OPENER & MIDDLE BREAK

CIRCLE LEFT:

Would you like to swing on a star

Carry moonbeams home in a jar

LEFT ALLEMANDE and then DO SA DO - the MEN STAR LEFT one time and go

Would you like to swing on a star – TURN THRU

LEFT ALLEMANDE and PROMENADE far

And be better off than you are

- or would you rather be a mule?

FIGURE (1)

HEADS SQUARE THRU: - A mule is an animal with long funny ears

TOUCH A QUARTER, SCOOTBACK and then

SINGLE HINGE, GIRLS TRADE and now SWING THRU

BOYS RUN RIGHT, TAG THE LINE all the way – FACE IN

PASS THE OCEAN – CENTRES TRADE

RECYCLE – STAR THRU and PROMENADE

And by the way, if you hate to go to school

- You may grow up to be a mule

HEADS SQUARE THRU: - A pig is an animal with dirt on his face

But if you don't care a feather or a fig

- You may grow up to be a pig

FIGURE (3 & 4)

HEADS SQUARE THRU: - A fish won't do anything, but swim in a brook

But then if that sort of life is what you wish

- You may grow up to be a fish

CLOSER

SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE

Would you like to swing on a star

Or would you rather - ALLEMANDE LEFT and WEAVE THE RING
