OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK
Circle left
It's knowing that your door is always open
And your path is free to walk
Left allemande your corner, come home a dosado
The men star left now
Turn thru at home, with the corner allemande
Swing your own and promenade
You're moving on the backroads
By the rivers of my memory
For hours you're just gentle on my mind

FIGURE

Heads (sides) promenade, 1/2 way round the ring Down the middle square thru go 4 4 hands and then, right & left thru my friend Pass thru, trade by, swing thru the outside two Boys you trade, turn thru somehow Left allemande and promenade You're moving on the backroads By the rivers of my memory For hours you're just (gentle on my mind)

CLOSER

Sides face, grand square
The wheat fields & clotheslines & junk cars
And the highways come between us
And some other woman's crying to her mother
Cause she turned and I was gone
Allemande and weave
I stood in rain in silence till the doorknob stained my face
And the summer sun might burn me till I'm blind
But not to where I cannot see you walking
